

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how BONK Community Foundation (“we”, “us”, “our”) uses cookies and similar tracking technologies on bonkcoin.com (the “Site”). By using the Site, you consent to the use of cookies in accordance with this policy. You may withdraw consent at any time by adjusting your cookie preferences using the link at the bottom of any page.

1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on your device by websites you visit. They are widely used to make websites work efficiently and to provide information to website operators. Cookies may be “session” cookies (which expire when you close your browser) or “persistent” cookies (which remain on your device for a set period or until deleted).

2. Cookies We Use

2.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are required for the Site to function and cannot be switched off. They are usually set in response to actions you take, such as setting your privacy preferences or navigating the Site. You can set your browser to block these cookies, but some parts of the Site may not work as a result.

- Session management cookies
- Cookie consent preference storage
- Security and fraud prevention tokens

2.2 Analytics Cookies

These cookies allow us to count visits and measure how users interact with the Site, so we can improve its performance. All information collected is aggregated and anonymous. These cookies are only set if you accept them.

- Google Analytics (or equivalent): measures page views, session duration, traffic sources, and user navigation paths. IP addresses are anonymized.
- Performance monitoring: measures site load times and error rates to support technical improvements.

2.3 Functional Cookies

These cookies enable enhanced functionality such as remembering your language or regional preferences. They are only set if you accept them.

- Language and regional preference cookies

2.4 Third-Party and Embedded Content Cookies

The Site may include links or embedded content from third-party platforms (for example, social media widgets or video embeds). These third parties may set their own cookies subject to their own privacy policies, over which we have no control. These cookies are only loaded if you accept non-essential cookies.

3. Managing Your Cookie Preferences

You can manage your preferences in the following ways:

- Cookie preference center: Click 'Cookie Settings' in the footer of any page to adjust your preferences at any time.
- Browser settings: Most browsers allow you to refuse or delete cookies. Refer to your browser's help documentation. Note that disabling all cookies may impair the functionality of some parts of the Site.
- Opt-out tools: For analytics cookies, you may use the Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on or equivalent tools provided by the relevant third party.

4. California Residents

We do not sell personal information as defined under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) or the California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA). California residents have the right to know what personal information is collected, to request deletion, and to opt out of the sharing of personal information for cross-context behavioural advertising.
